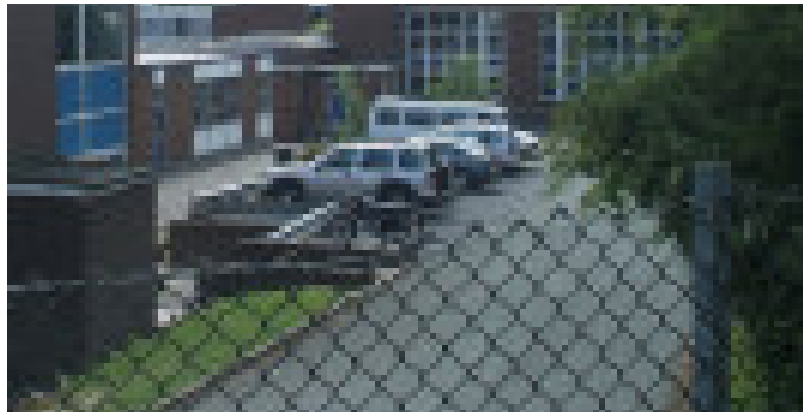

Site Security and Boundaries

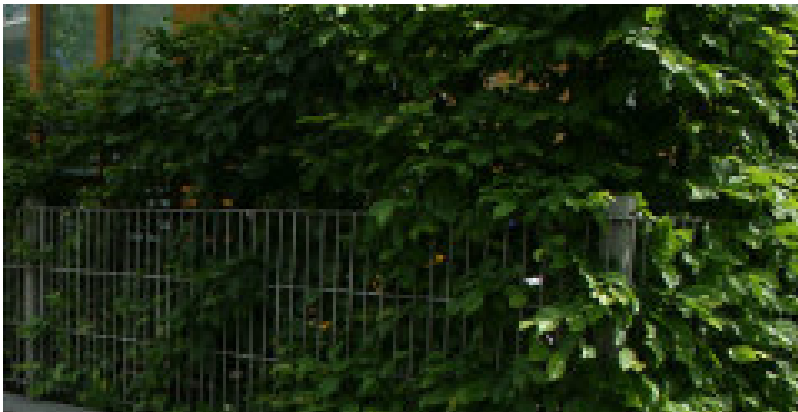
- Need to consider:
 - Protection of pupils - Safeguarding
 - Protection of property
 - Protection of facilities – Investment by community
 - Access by public
 - Segregation of users – safety and usability of facilities

Boundary Types - Now



- Existing fences and boundary treatments
 - Palisade
 - Planted
 - Wire mesh
 - Stave
 - Planted
 - Open

Boundary Types - Possible



- Existing types plus:
 - Weldmesh
 - Backing up planting with fencing

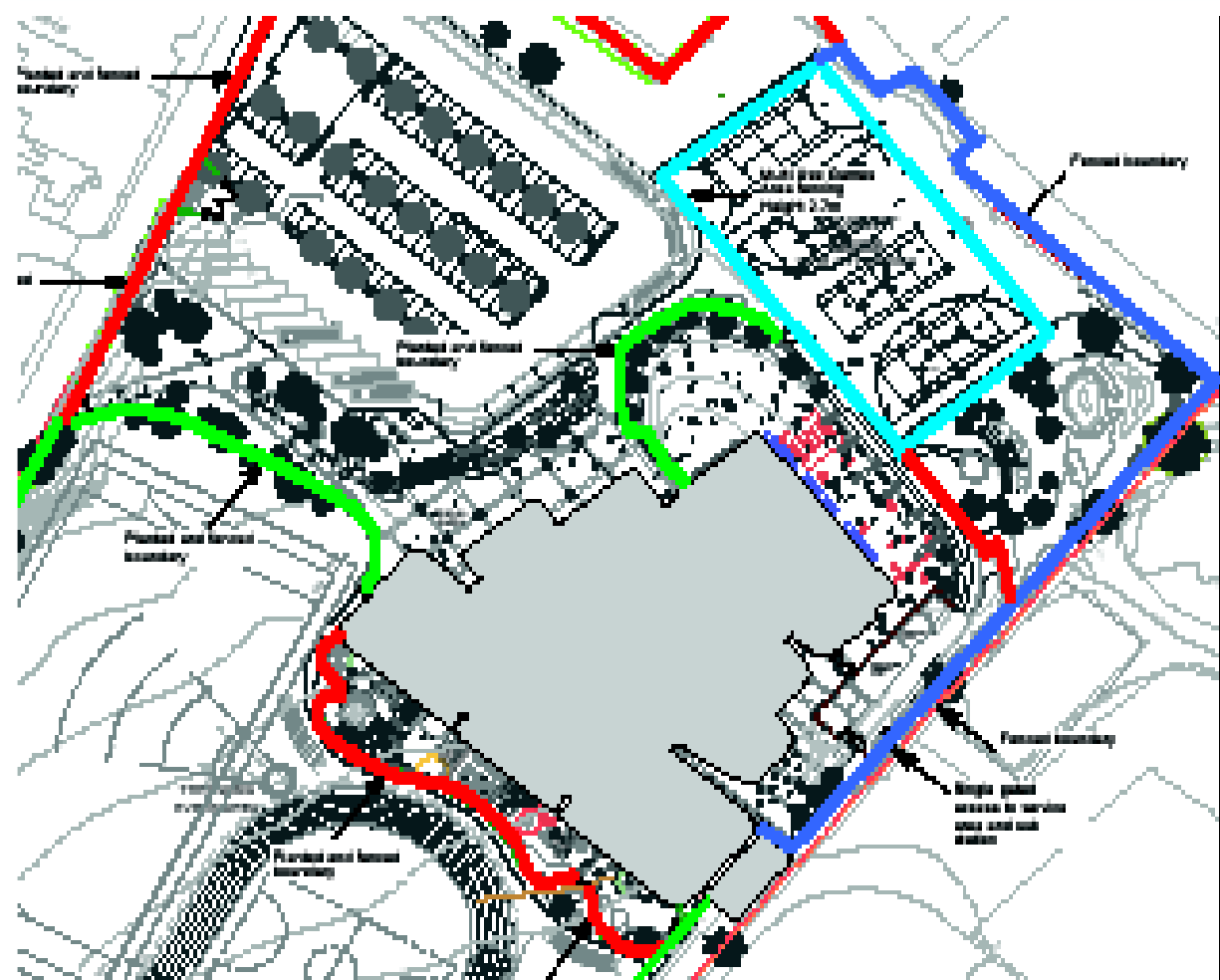

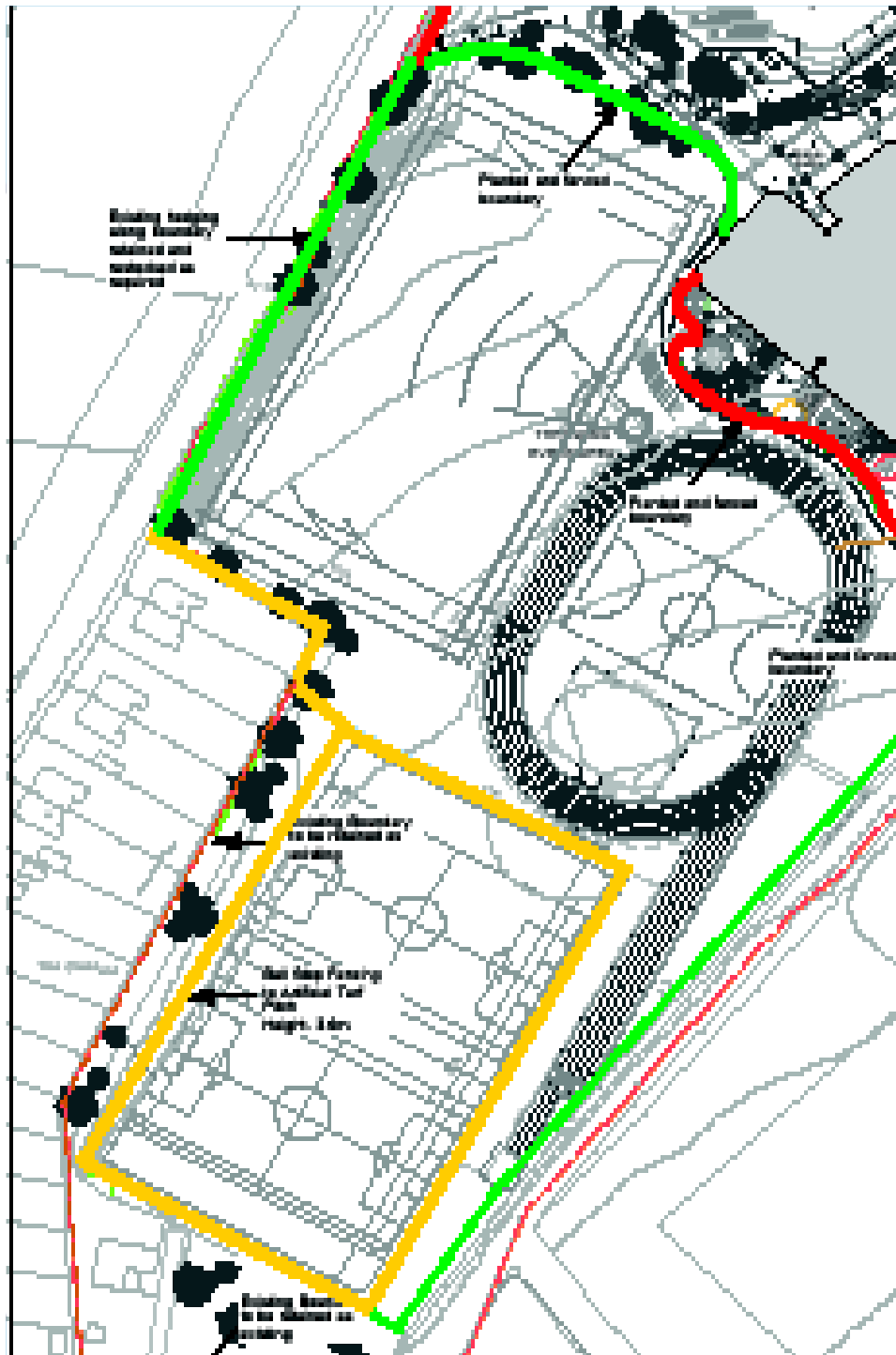
Boundary Proposal

- Path from Station Road to remain open
- Mainly weldmesh around whole site:
 - Protection of pupils and staff
 - Protection of property and facilities
 - Safety and segregation of users
- Ball courts/gardens/car park slightly different treatment

Our environment

- We want to feel safe – anyone can walk in to our present school and site
- We want staff and students to feel relaxed in the new school and trust people
- Potential theft – recent example
- We want to look after and protect new school facilities as they are so good

Our environment

- We think there is a risk from cigarettes, broken glass, chewing gum, dog faeces, etc outside
- We want to give priority to people who have booked – it is difficult to ask people who shouldn't be there to move on – they can be scary

What we want to keep

- We want to keep the feeling of an open space so the colour and type of fencing is important
- We want to make it clear how people get in to the site and the facilities
- We want clear signs and directions
- At the entrance to the school we want plasma screens for information and notices as well as pictures of good things that have happened
